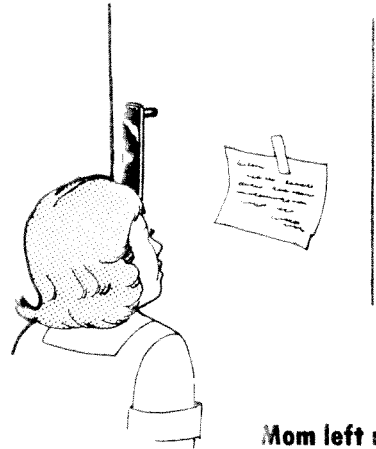


THE RULE The N-V-IO-DO sentence pattern consists of a subject, a verb, an indirect object, and a direct object.
